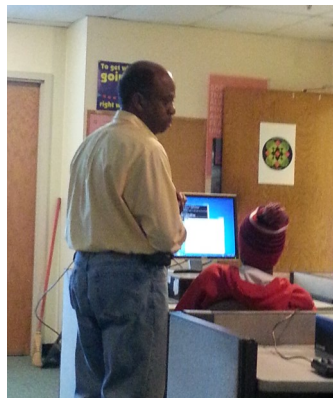

Computer Village Teaches Networking Basics

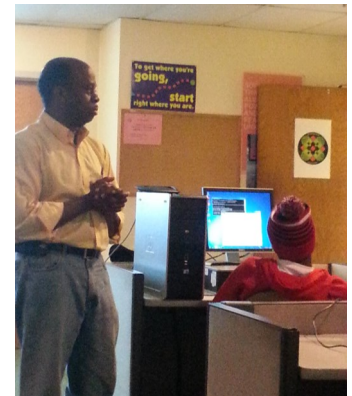
